Sanctions – Russian Iron and Steel

Sanctions have been placed on Russia by countries across the globe, including a ban on the use of Russian iron and steel.

As part of this, the UK, under the Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and the EU under Council Regulation (EU) 2023/1214 (“2023 Regulations”) amending Regulation (EU) No 833/2014, introduced a prohibition on the import of certain Russian iron and steel products processed in a third country or multiple third countries. The prohibition on the import of Russian iron and steel products processed in a third country came into effect from 30th September 2023 and applies only to goods imported into the UK and EU after this date.

Our supply chain partners have confirmed that no component parts provided to BPR Medical Ltd after 30th September 2023 contain any Russian iron or steel and this will continue to be the case whilst these sanctions are in place. Our supply chain partners’ continued compliance with regulations will be monitored through our standard operating procedure for managing ongoing supplier compliance.
